The Scrap Mixology pattern modules are designed to help you tailor a block to the scraps you have. *Two Bits* is perfect for your strips and small scraps.


Before the class, you will want to review all of the pages of the pattern and start thinking about how you might use the scraps you have in both scrap size and color. You will find the basic block-cutting instructions on page 3. This basic block uses a nine-patch as a starting point. You do not need to make the 9-patch in class. If you want to swap out any of the other centers on pages 8-11, feel free.

It would help if you also thought about what layout you want your blocks in. You can see some examples on pages 4-6. Doing this class preparation will assist you in deciding what scraps (or fabrics) to bring. It is not necessary to have your fabric cut before class. As we start discussing the pattern, you might decide to go in

Supplies you will need:

- A printout of the *Two Bits* pattern
- Working sewing machine and knowledge of how to use it
- Appropriate-sized scraps in the colors you want to use. This is a great pattern for all those strings. It is not necessary to bring all of your scraps – if you are doing a rainbow of blocks, maybe bring just 3-5 colors to class
- Rotary cutter and scissors
- General sewing supplies (thread, seam ripper, pins, etc)
- A square ruler that is 10.5" square or larger for squaring up the blocks
